Rusty Hancock made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, consisting of minutes of the previous Regular Meeting on June 26, 2018. The motion also included the approval of the June Financial Report, June Tax Report and June bills in the amount of \$1,153,670.45. Harold Gates is asking for the re-zone located at 508 Brooklyn. There was no one from the Public in opposition of the re-zone. Brian Walton made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Tim Yee seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.
