Brian Walton made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of minutes of the previous meeting on March 13, 2018, with corrections. Tim Yee seconded the motion and same carried unanimously.

The Council tabled the request and first reading of **Ordinance 2018-08** on the proposed zone change of Lot 1, Block 1, John C. Williams Addition, City of Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas from R-3 Residential to Special Use Zoning to place a manufactured home. Miguel Pino has asked for the re-zone at 301 Tennessee. This request was tabled by the Planning and Zoning Commission. The manufactured home Mr. Pino was going to purchase has been sold so he will apply again for the zone change once he has found another manufactured home.

Tim Yee made a motion to approve the recommendation from the DEDC to provide matching funds for a grant in the amount of \$100,000 for vocational training at Frank Phillips College. Clinton Hale seconded the motion and the same carried with Brian Walton abstaining.
