

**DALHART CITY COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2022**

The Dalhart City Council met in regular session in Council Chambers on Monday, February 14, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. Tim Yee, Mayor Pro-Tem, called the meeting to order. A quorum was present. Tim Yee led the prayer, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited to the United States and Texas Flags. Members present were:

Bryan Brewer made a motion to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes of the previous Regular Meeting on January 24, 2022, and the special meeting on February 7, 2022. The motion also included the approval of the January Financial Report, January Tax Report, and January bills in the amount of \$1,055,918.41. Ginger Cleavinger made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2022-02, an ordinance of the City Council of the City of Dalhart, Texas, calling the City's regular election to be held on May 7, 2022. Sherri Haschke seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Sherri Haschke made a motion to approve the recommendation from the Hotel Occupancy Tax Committee to help fund Dalhart Cruzers 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Muscle Car Weekend in the amount of \$10,725. Ian Van Den Heever seconded the motion with Ginger Cleavinger and Bryan Brewer abstaining. Motion passed with 6 aye's and 2 abstaining.

There was no discussion of future agenda items.

Comments from City Manager and Department Heads: Interim City Manager Melissa Vossmer mentioned that the lake board met today to finalize the plans for the Amphitheater at the lake, but they did not finalize today. They will meet again on Tuesday March 1, 2022 and will likely have a finalized plan.

There being no further business, Sherri Haschke made a motion to adjourn. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.
