

**DALHART CITY COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
MONDAY, MARCH 28, 2022**

The Dalhart City Council met in regular session in Council Chambers on Monday, March 28, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. Justin Moore Mayor, called the meeting to order. A quorum was present. Parker Noel led the prayer, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited to the United States and Texas Flags. Members present were:

Bryan Brewer made a motion to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes of the previous Regular Meeting on March 14, 2022. Ian Van Den Heever seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

There were no public comments.

Eloy Duran, Interim Police Chief was asked for comment by Mayor Moore. In his comment he stated that in November 2021, there was a call for aggravated assault that resulted in a felony. He also stated the concern of her staff situation and the ability to see everything that is going on at events. After discussion Tim Yee made a motion to deny the request to establish an ordinance authorizing the sale of beer between midnight and 2:00am, allowing La Barranca Bar to apply for a late hour's permit. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Ginger Cleavinger made a motion to Deny the request to lower the interest rate on liens placed on a property owned by Jon King from 10% to 6%. Ian Van Den Heever seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Sherri Haschke made a motion to adopt **Resolution 2022-02** worded as follows:
**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF DALHART, TEXAS, ("CITY")
RESPONDING TO THE APPLICATION OF ATMOS ENERGY
CORPORATION – WEST TEXAS DIVISION, TO INCREASE RATES
UNDER THE GAS RELIABILITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM;
SUSPENDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RATE APPLICATION
FOR FORTY-FIVE DAYS; DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT**

WHICH THE RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED COMPLIED WITH THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT; MAKING SUCH OTHER FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Tim Yee seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Tim Yee made a motion to change the Ordinance number to 2022-03 and adopt **Ordinance 2022-03** an ordinance of the City of Dalhart establishing a speed limit zone on a part of US HWY 87, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewithin; and providing a penalty, effective date, and publication. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

City Council Convened into executive session under Texas local government code 551.074 for the discussion of City Manager Recruitment with Strategic Government Resources at 6:24 pm.

City Council reconvened from executive session at 6:58 pm. No action was taken.

Council discussed what other fund balances they may be able to pull the money from in order to pay for the basketball goals. Councilman Yee wanted to consider a presentation to the Economic Development Committee. Councilwoman Haschke explained that the request may not meet the requirements and if it did, the money could be held up for sixty (60) days. Councilman Smith mentioned tabling the discussion to review fund balances to find the ability to fund this request. Tim Yee made a motion to table the request from Dalhart Youth Basketball for funds to help purchase two (2) roll away basketball goals until the April 11, 2022, meeting. Dwayne Smith seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Discussion of future agenda items: Ginger Cleavinger wanted to add a discussion regarding the debris coming from our landfill.

There were no comments from department heads.

There being no further business, Sherri Haschke made a motion to adjourn. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.
