

**DALHART CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
THURSDAY, MAY 12, 2022**

The Dalhart City Council met in special session in Council Chambers on Thursday, May 12, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. Justin Moore Mayor, called the meeting to order. A quorum was present. Justin Moore led the prayer, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited to the United States and Texas Flags. Members present were:

Mayor Moore made a motion to appoint Sherri Haschke, Ian Van Den Heever, and John Loepky as the Canvass Committee to canvass the Election returns of the May 7th General Election. On completing the canvass, Councilmember John Loepky declared the following votes were received at the May 7, 2022, election and the figures on the tally sheets were tallied as shown:

John Loepky made a motion to adopt **Ordinance 2022-05** on ordinance and order canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the City of Dalhart, May 7th, 2022, General Election. Sherri Haschke seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Wendy Kleynhans, City Secretary, administered the Oath of Office and Statement of Elected Officer to the newly elected officials. Justin Moore, Mayor, presented the newly elected officials with the Certificate of Election.

On the next item to elect a Mayor Pro-Tem, there were three (3) nominations. Justin Moore nominated Parker Noel, Bryan Brewer nominated Ginger Cleavinger, and Dwayne Smith nominated Sherri Haschke. The vote was as follows Parker Noel with 0 aye's and

4 nays, and 3 members with no vote given. Ginger Cleavinger with 5 aye's, 0 nays, and 3 members with no vote given. Sherri Haschke with 0 aye's and no opposition vote taken. Majority vote was in favor of electing Councilwoman Ginger Cleavinger as Mayor Pro-Tem.

There being no further business, Sherri Haschke made a motion to adjourn. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.
