

Incentive Zones: Community Improvement District (CID), New Market Tax Credit (NMTC)

Incentive Zone Details: The property resides in a High Opportunity Area per CMF and is not classified as a low-income or economic distress area. It is not in an Opportunity Zone but is eligible for New Market Tax Credit benefits, Community Development Block Grant funds, the Emergency Relief Program, and the 48C tax credit (excluding the energy community portion). These designations may grant access to various federal incentives for investment, relief, and community development.

Additional Details: The property is located in Dallam County within Census Tract 9503 and qualifies for several incentive and abatement programs. It is not in an Opportunity Zone, but is eligible for New Market Tax Credits, Community Development Block Grants, Emergency Relief Program incentives, and a 48C tax credit (but not the energy community portion). The site is also in a High Opportunity Area. For these programs, eligibility is based on the tract's characteristics and federal or state program criteria. Funds are aimed at community development, investment, and relief efforts. See each program's respective administration for specific eligibility criteria and benefits.





Broadband Technology Information

Fiber to the Premises: Provides the fastest and most reliable internet connections using fiber optic cables directly to the building. Typical speeds range from 100 Mbps to 5 Gbps or more.

Cable: Uses the same coaxial cable as cable television service to deliver broadband. Typically offers download speeds from 25 Mbps to 1 Gbps, with upload speeds usually lower than download.

Copper/DSL: Uses existing telephone lines to deliver broadband. Typically slower than cable or fiber, with speeds ranging from 1 Mbps to 100 Mbps depending on the distance from the central office.

Fixed Wireless: Transmits data using radio signals rather than cables. Speeds vary widely depending on the technology, from 5 Mbps to 100+ Mbps.

5G: The newest generation of cellular technology offering high-speed internet access. Can provide speeds from 50 Mbps to 1 Gbps or more, depending on network conditions and proximity to cell towers.
