REGULAR MEETING
TUESDAY, MARCH 12, 2019**

Rusty Hancock made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, consisting of minutes of the previous Regular Meeting on February 26, 2019. Mayor Hass opened the Public Hearing for the adoption of **Resolution 2019-01**, captioned as follows:

HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.**

Clinton Hale made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Sherri Haschke seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously. Clinton Hale made a motion to adopt **Resolution 2019-01**. Tim Yee seconded the motion the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Rusty Hancock made a motion to adopt **Resolution 2019-02**, setting a date for a Public Hearing for March 26, 2019 at 6:10 p.m. The Public Hearing will determine whether certain conditions constitute a public nuisance at 901 E. 1st Street. The Council viewed pictures of the property. Tim Yee seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Rusty Hancock made a motion to adopt **Resolution 2019-03**, supporting the extension of Interstate 27. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously. City Manager Stroud stated this is part of the Ports to Plains Corridor project and intersects with Interstate 40, Interstate 20, and Interstate 10.

City Manager Stroud reported that an informational letter is being prepared to try and educate the Public on property taxes.

Stroud added that a drive-thru of the lake trails will take place on the afternoon of April 27, 2019. The Public is invited to take part in the drive-thru.

There being no further business, Sherri Haschke made a motion to adjourn. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.
