REGULAR MEETING

Brian Walton made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, consisting of minutes of the previous Regular Meeting on February 11 and Special Meeting on February 5, 2020. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Public Comments:

Fire Marshal Curtis Brown invited everyone in attendance to come by the Fire Station for a tour. The current fire station is in need of many repairs. The City will hold a Special Bond Election on May 2, 2020 for a new fire station.

Agenda item #2 was to consider and act upon recommendation from the Planning & Zoning Commission and conduct the first reading of **Ordinance 2020-02** on proposed zone change of Lots 19-20, Block 36, Blair Division, City of Dalhart, Dallam County Texas from R-3 Residential to special Use Zoning to place a new manufactured home. The owners of the property are Norma & Gabriel Estrada and is located at 802 Channing. Brian Walton made a motion to table this agenda item. Tim Yee seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously. This agenda item was tabled due to no quorum at the Planning & Zoning meeting scheduled on February 24, 2020. David Conner, Police Chief, presented the Dalhart Police Report for FY2019. The report included Department Activity, Patrol Activity, Animal Control Activity, FY2019 Budget Items, and Projections for FY2020. Brian Walton made a motion to approve the report. Troy Ferguson seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.
