DALHART CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2020

The Dalhart City Council met in regular session in Council Chambers on Tuesday, November 10, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. Clinton Hale, Mayor, called the meeting to order. A quorum was present. Brian Walton led the prayer. Members present were:

Brian Walton made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of minutes of the previous Regular Meeting on October 27, 2020. The motion also included the approval of the October Financial Report, October Tax Report and October bills in the amount of \$1,381,412.94. Sherri Haschke seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Council had one public comment from Tammy Parker regarding water service being disconnected due to no payment of a \$15 late fee and asked for the City to show some grace.

Brian Walton made a motion to open the second Public Hearing and second reading of **Ordinance 2020-13** on the proposed zone change of A Tract of land 235 feet wide, East and West, and 370 feet in length, North and South Section 5, Block 48, H&TC RY Co, City of Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas from R-3 Residential & Commercial to Manufactured Home to establish a manufactured home park. The property belongs to Thomas Berryman and is located at 901 East 1st Street. Rusty Hancock Seconded the motion. Brian Walton made a motion to close the public hearing. Rusty Hancock seconded and the same carried unanimously. There were no objections.

Brian Walton made a motion to adopt **Ordinance 2020-13** re-zoning A Tract of land 235 feet wide, East and West, and 370 feet in length, North and South Section 5, Block 48, H&TC RY Co, City of Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas from R-3 Residential & Commercial to Manufactured Home to establish a manufactured home park. Sherri Haschke seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Brian Walton made a motion to open the Public Hearing on the proposed Annexation of 116.42 acre tract of land in the North portion of a 159.35 acre tract of land according to that certain Warranty Deed recorded under Clerk's File No 176013 of the Official Public Records of Dallam County, Texas in Section 5, Block 48, H. & T. C. RR Co., Dallam County, Texas, and being further described by metes and bounds. Sherri Haschke seconded. Brian Walton made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Sherri Haschke seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously. There were no objections.

Brian Walton made a motion to adopt **Ordinance 2020-18**, captioned as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED
TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF DALHART, DALLAM COUNTY,
TEXAS AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID CITY
SO AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY
WITHIN SAID CITY LIMITS, AND GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS
OF SAID PROPERTY ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF OTHER
CITIZENS AND BINDING SAID INHABITANTS BY ALL OF THE ACTS,
ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY;
ADOPTING A SERVICE PLAN AND OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION
THEREWITH AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Sherri Haschke seconded and the same carried unanimously.

Brian Walton made a motion to approve the recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission and conduct first reading of **Ordinance 2020-19** on the proposed zone change of North 50' of Lot 8-10, Block 60, Blair Division, City of Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas from R-3 Residential to Special Use for the purpose of placing a manufactured home. The property owner is Jose Medina and is located at 1009 Pine Street. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Brian Walton made a motion to approve the recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission and conduct first reading of **Ordinance 2020-20** on the proposed zone change of lot 3 and 13' of lot 4, Block 20, Blair Division, City of Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas from R-3 Residential to Special Use for the purpose of placing a manufactured home. The property owner is Dennis Wheeler and is located at 1103 Omaha Street. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Brian Walton made a motion to approve the recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission and conduct first reading of **Ordinance 2020-21** on the proposed zone change of lot 7 and 8, Block 26, Blair Division, City of Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas from R-3 Residential to Special Use for the purpose of placing a manufactured home. The property owner is Karla Galindo-Hernandez and it located at 1215 Lincoln Street. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Brian Walton made a motion to adopt **Ordinance 2020-22** captioned as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALHART,
TEXAS RE-ADOPTING THE JUVENILE CURFEW ORDINANCE; DECLARING
CERTAIN CONDUCT UNLAWFUL; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND
ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS FOR
ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Sherri Haschke seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Rusty Hancock made a motion to approve the bid from G&G Operators in the amount of \$28,680.00 for 4th Street Brick Repair and also approved an amendment to the budget if necessary. Brian Walton seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Brian Walton made a motion to appoint Police Chief, David Conner, as Local Rabies Control Authority. Bryan Brewer seconded the motion and the rest carried unanimously.

Brian Walton made a motion to approve the TML Health Benefits Pool changes. Rusty Hancock seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously.

Brian Walton made a motion to maintain the same level of funding as last year for Occupancy Tax applicants for 2021. Following are the amounts recommended and approved by the Council. Sherri Haschke seconded the motion and the same carried unanimously. The amounts awarded are as follows:
